DCM: Liz F. reporting. (1) From Mini Assembly II and Delegates Conference Report, June 10: GSO lease in NYC will be up in a few years, comparing options. New Grapevine/La Vina App is slated for September launch. There were several conference advisory actions (passed with a 2/3 majority vote): GSB to conduct a thorough inventory of itself during the 2025 General Service Conference; minor updates to pamphlets and informational publications; the pamphlet The 12 Traditions Illustrated with new graphics will be approved; pamphlet Too Young will be retired and replaced with a video; suggested contribution for delegate expense for the conference raised from \$1800 to \$2000; Trustees Finance and Budgetary Committee develop additional ways to report the quarterly fiscal performance; the AA Service Manual will not be printed in 2023 - there will be a rewrite of Chapters 8-12.
